



Holy Trinity Continued Reopening Plan

Start Date: March 13, 2022

Stages are based on the most current CDC COVID-19 Community Level Guidance. Levels can be Low (Green), Medium (Yellow), or Red (High). Reopening stages will be based on these levels; Low (Green)-HT will continue to next stage, at Medium (Yellow) and High (Red)-HT will stop at current stage and will follow all guidance/mandates that may be issued by local or state health departments/authorities. The Council will continue to evaluate the numbers and stages every two weeks.

March 27, 2022 (Tentatively)*

Return of a small coffee hour following church service(s).

- coffee hour will be limited to:
 - Coffee, Tea, Water, and other beverages
 - Doughnuts, pastries, or other small food offerings
 - No large/full buffet style offerings

April 10, 2022 (Tentatively)*

Return of Children's Time at Chancel Steps

May 8, 2022 (Tentatively)*

Passing of the Peace and Collecting of Offerings and Tithes

May 22, 2022 (Tentatively)*

Return to Chapel for 8:30 Worship Service

June 5, 2022 (Tentatively)*

High touch items will be returned to pews/chairs in both Main Church and Chapel

*Stages will open every two weeks as long as CDC Level remains at the Low (Green) Level. Data will be monitored every Wednesday morning in order to determine if Holy Trinity will move forward in the reopening plan. This two-week period is to ensure safety effectiveness at each stage. Information on current CDC Community Risk Level of Erie County will be reported in the weekly email as well as the decision to open the next stage or to pause at current stage.
